On June 22, 2004, Mark Esherick and Rick Krupka of Siemens met at Supercom with Bryan Tramont, Chief of Staff of the Office of Chairman Michael Powell to show him new DECT phones, which include camera-ready, MMS, and SMS features as well as other impressive technology upgrades. We also reviewed the DECT Forum's proposed rule change associated with the UPCS spectrum that would support the FCC policy goals of promoting more efficient and flexible use of the spectrum. Those changes include: remove fixed channelization, set maximum bandwidth of 2.5 MHz, extend the isochronous band down to 1915 MHz, and remove the packing rule, section 15.323(b).
