

As a newcomer to the Wireless arena, we have discovered that the existence of unlicensed spectrum is, in fact, to the advantage of a small business owner. The opening of additional spectrum would assist in the continuing growth of the small business market.

Cable and DSL providers find it cost prohibitive to extend service to the "last mile" market. Wireless allows for a cost effective means to do so, and opens up larger markets for the small business owner to service.

We, as a company, would like to express our interest in opening up the 3.65 to 3.70 Ghz spectrum for unlicensed use. In addition, we would consider the EIRP limit of 25 Watts to be sufficient.

Unlicensed use does not mean unregulated. The FCC still retains the power to oversee and regulate the use of this spectrum, and I encourage this supervision. Through proper use of this spectrum, we, as operators, can prevent any interference with other spectrums, licensed or otherwise.
