

As co-owner and president of a small wireless ISP in Oregon, I strongly support the initiative to open up the 3650 MHz band for unlicensed use. While I understand the concern that the new equipment would interfere with the satellite bands, I believe that with careful planning these qualms can be addressed.

The current unlicensed spectrum is becoming more and more crowded as a larger percentage of the population turns to wireless 802.1x and fixed wireless broadband. This additional spectrum, with the increased power limit, would allow us to reach more rural customers than ever before.
