On Wednesday June 30, 2004, Lawrence Krevor, Vice President – Government Affairs of Nextel Communications (“Nextel”) spoke via telephone with Michael Wilhelm and Aaron Goldberger of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau (“Bureau”) regarding the Commission’s above-referenced proceeding on public safety communications in the 800 MHz band.

Nextel discussed the filing of follow-up information by both Southern LINC and Nextel, in light of a joint meeting held by Southern LINC, Nextel and Bureau staff on June 25, 2004. The requested follow-up information was filed separately by Southern LINC and Nextel on June 30, 2004.¹
