On behalf of QUALCOMM Incorporated (“QUALCOMM”), this is to report that today, Jonas Neihardt, QUALCOMM’s Vice President, Federal Affairs, and I had a brief conversation with Sheryl Wilkerson, Senior Legal Adviser to Chairman Powell, in which I reiterated QUALCOMM’s position that the Commission should not adopt any change to the PCS base station power limit that includes any per carrier limit because any per carrier limit would have an adverse impact on CDMA and WCDMA networks, as well as networks using future wideband technologies.
