Alyrica Networks, Inc. is a wireless internet service provider (WISP) servicing metropolitan and rural areas in Western Oregon's Willamette Valley. As the FCC is obviously aware, WISPs like Alyrica are at the forefront of the battle to bring competitive high speed internet and IP connectivity to rural areas. We ourselves are currently in the process of bringing coverage to the underserved mid-Willamette valley rural area with two planned new deployments in the next 30 to 90 days.

As Network Administrator and a company shareholder, I can tell you what a vital role unlicensed spectrum plays in our business. I note with pleasure the proposal outlined in proceeding 04-151 for opening additional spectrum for unlicensed devices in the 900Mhz and 3Ghz bands. Although organizations such as the satellite industry will no doubt voice concerns, I would encourage the FCC to **move forward with this proposal** trusting that appropriate rulemaking coupled with cognitive technologies will allow wireless internet services to happily coexist with incumbent users.



Alyrica has been and continues to be a local force in bringing IP service to out of the way places. We are also looking at entering the market as manufacturers of equipment operating in unlicensed spectrum. The continued support of the FCC will help to foster an environment where this is possible.
