This letter, pursuant to Section 1.1206(b)(2), provides notification of several oral *ex parte* presentations of The Boeing Company (“Boeing”) in the above referenced proceeding.

On September 17, 2004, Audrey Allison and Carlos Nalda of Boeing and I met with Sheryl J. Wilkerson, legal assistant to Chairman Powell, and I separately spoke by telephone with Bryan Tramont, Chief of Staff to Chairman Powell. On September 20, 2004, Ms. Allison, Russell Fox of this firm and I met with Jennifer Manner, Senior Counsel to Commissioner Abernathy; Paul Margie, Spectrum and International Legal Advisor to Commissioner Capps; and Sam Feder, Legal Advisor on Spectrum and International Issues to Commissioner Martin. In each instance, we discussed Boeing’s proposal that the FCC issue up to four (4) authorizations in the 800 MHz air-to-ground service. The discussions were consistent with Boeing’s previously submitted pleadings and presentations in this proceeding.
