Dear Ms. Dortch:

This is to inform you that AirCell, Inc. ("AirCell") representatives Bill Gordon, Vice President for Government Affairs; Grant Saroka, technical consultant to AirCell; and I, counsel to AirCell, participated in an *ex parte* meeting on October 19, 2004 with John Muleta, Roger Noel and Gregory Vadas of the Wireless Telecommunication Bureau ("WTB") regarding the above-referenced proceeding.

During the meeting, AirCell reviewed the attached presentation which outlined a new simplified technical approach for sharing the Air-to-Ground ("ATG") band between two broadband providers. AirCell emphasized the importance of providing for broadband competition within the ATG band, and repeated its opposition to auctioning the band as a single 4 MHz license.
