
Dear Ms. Dortch:

Yesterday, William Berkman, Chairman of Current Technologies, Inc., and I met with Commissioner Abernathy and Jennifer Manner, Commissioner Abernathy's Senior Counsel.

Mr. Berkman described (a) Current's interactions with the experts at the FCC's Office of Engineering and Technology and the National Telecommunications and Information Administration and (b) his belief that the experts were making very good progress toward technical rules that would accommodate both radio and BPL use of frequencies below 80 MHz. Mr. Berkman also indicated Current's hope that the Commission would consider and resolve the outstanding Notice of Proposed Rulemaking at its October 14 meeting.
