
Dear Ms. Dortch:

On October 20, 2004, Edward Laase and Carlos Nalda of the The Boeing Company and the undersigned met with the Commission staff listed in Attachment A to discuss AirCell's proposal for the deployment of two cross-polarized systems in the air-to-ground band, which AirCell presented at the meeting. Boeing explained that, in the interest of developing a consensus proposal that would enable the Commission to license two broadband air-to-ground providers, it had withdrawn the proposal embodied in its September 10, 2004 submission in this proceeding and is supporting the approach put forward at the meeting by AirCell while continuing to work with AirCell on the technical details of that approach.
