Pursuant to 1.1206 of the Commission's rules, this notice informs the Federal Communications Commission that the undersigned, on behalf of Intel Corporation ("Intel"), met with Commissioner Kevin J. Martin and Daniel Gonzalez, Senior Legal Assistant to Commissioner Martin, on November 12, 2004.

Intel presented the attached slides on the reallocation of TV broadcast channels 60-69 as part of the digital television ("DTV") transition. Intel addressed the value of these channels for advanced wireless services and advocated clearing all stations on channels 60-69 simultaneously, rather than just clearing the public safety co-channel stations. Intel explained that this approach would most effectively address public safety concerns, while greatly increasing the value of the C and D blocks (especially to rural areas).
